Band members will need to bring a lunch or
have arrangements made for the lunch break.
Students will be dismissed for lunch **AFTER** the
trailers are loaded. If you are leaving with a
parent for lunch, they should arrive around 1:00
so that the trailer will be fully loaded. When
loading the trailers, make sure you have your
instrument, flags, sticks, reeds, uniform, shoes,
black socks, hat, and all other uniform parts.
Do not have another student load anything for
you. **DOUBLE CHECK EVERYTHING!!**

No student will be allowed to ride home with
parents unless they have filled out the
appropriate form in advance. The reason for
leaving the group early must be a valid excuse.
Any student that leaves with a parent will still be
expected to meet at the school to help unload
equipment, instruments, and uniforms after the
band arrives at home.

Upon arrival at Plymouth after the contest, each
band member is responsible for unloading his/
her equipment. All percussion members are
responsible for all percussion instruments and
all guard members are responsible for all guard
equipment. **No percussion or guard students
will be permitted to leave until all of the
equipment is put away properly.**
