Your assignment is simple:

You will open the attached link to a set of Music Theory games. After you play the game, you will take a screen shot of your ENTIRE SCREEN so I can see the game and your score at the top. You will then email your screen shots for your grade. bames@plymouth.k12.in.us

Game #1 - NOTE NAME IDENTIFICATION

You will be given a series of 20 notes to identify. The trick on this is to watch and be aware of your key signature and any accidentals. You only get one chance per note to identify the name of the note.

Game #2 - INTERVAL RECOGNITION

You will do a total of 20 intervals. Your score will be based on the number of correct intervals you identify out of the 20. The trick on this one is that you are TIMED!! You have 60 seconds to identify the interval and then, it will move to the next question. Be careful to pay attention to the key signature!

In case you have forgotten... here is a "cheat" to help you through this.

0 steps = unison	7 steps = perfect 5th
1 step = minor 2nd	8 steps = minor 6th
2 steps = major 2nd	9 steps = major 6th
3 steps = minor 3rd	10 steps = minor 7th
4 steps = major 3rd	11 steps = major 7th
5 steps = perfect 4th	12 steps = octave
